Community Service Hours

Community service must be done without pay for a NON-PROFIT ORGANIZATION.

Non-profit organizations are organizations which do not earn a profit.

Fifty hours of community service is required to graduate from Temecula Preparatory School. Please use this requirement as an opportunity to learn about yourself and your interests. A commitment to community service is viewed favorably in the college application process and can provide work experience, which could lead to employment.

Most people volunteer within six miles of their own home. You are needed in your own backyard. Find a volunteer job that suits your skills, talents, interests and the time you have available.

Would you like to work with children? At a local school? For a crisis service or a volunteer fire department? In health care? With the homeless? Elderly? The disabled? Would you like to help people by teaching literacy or delivering meals to shut-ins? Would you like to help with youth sports programs?
